1. Enumerate the causes, and give the symptoms, diagnosis, and treatment of pyosalpinx.

2. Give the physical signs of a multilocular ovarian cyst reaching to the umbilicus, and contrast them with those of a uterine fibroid.

Under what circumstances would such a tumour give rise to acute symptoms, and what is the nature of these?

3. Describe the degenerations of fibroid tumours of the uterus, and give their clinical symptoms. Give the operation of supra-vaginal hysterectomy in detail.

4. What types of malignant disease may attack the uterus, and how would you proceed to investigate a case of suspected malignant disease of the body of the uterus?
