- 1. Discuss the etiology and pathology of leukaemia. Describe the variations in the blood and clinical picture in the different types of the disease. Indicate the general lines of treatment.
- 2. Describe in detail any one method of performing transfusion of blood. Name other methods, and indicate what precautions you would take to ascertain the suitability of any donor for transfusion.
- 3. Describe the development of red corpuscles, and discuss the bearing of this on the blood pictures of chlorosis, haemorrhagic anaemia, and pernicious anaemia.
- 4. What is leucopenia? Enumerate the more important diseases and conditions in which it does or may occur, and discuss its causation.
