DISEASES OF THE LUNGS AND PLEURAE

1. Discuss the prophylactic value of vaccines against pneumonia. Describe the serum treatment of lobar pneumonia and quote statistical evidence as to its value.
2. How may pulmonary gangrene arise? Describe the pathology, symptoms, clinical signs and treatment of this condition.
3. Mention a few of the industrial 'dusts' which have been described as responsible for chronic disease of the lungs. Discuss some of the more important points in differential diagnosis that may arise in such cases.
4. Discuss some of the more important points that may arise:—(a) in the diagnosis, (b) the treatment of pleural effusions.
