- 1. On what stages of development of *Plasmodium falciparum* and *P. vivax* do the following drugs act:—chloroquine, proguanil (paludrine), pyrimethamine (daraprium), pamaquine. What immediate treatment would you give to a patient suffering from a severe complicated *P. falciparum* infection?
- 2. Compare and contrast the epidemiology of yellow fever and rabies. Discuss briefly the methods of prevention and the risks associated therewith.
- 3. What lesions may be found in the secondary stage of yaws and how do these differ essentially from tertiary lesions? How would you plan an anti-yaws campaign for the control of this disease in a community?
- 4. What diseases may be simulated by Schistosoma mansoni infection? Discuss the differential diagnosis.
