2. Discuss the management of a male patient, aged 50 years, with a syphilitic aneurysm of the transverse part of the aorta.
3. Discuss the hazards of the penicillin therapy of syphilis (including the measures which should be taken for their avoidance).
4. Discuss the rôle of antibiotics in the treatment of non-gonococcal urethritis of the male.
