#### 6 Changes to the Laws

### **Motion A**

It was **resolved** by the requisite majority, 51 for, none against and 3 abstentions to permit the proposal and seconding of amendments to motions at College meetings and to amend Law 10 of Chapter XV by electronic means by making the following amendments to the Laws:-

- 1. In Law 10 of Chapter XV of Motions, Laws and Protests, delete the word "signed" as it appears in the first sentence. And
- 2. Add the following new Chapter and Law:-

# "CHAPTER XXIV DEFINITIONS

- 1. In these Laws unless the context provides otherwise:-
  - 1.1 "electronically" means, in relation to the sending or supply of a document or information, the sending or supply by electronic means or by any other means while in an electronic form.
  - 1.2 "writing" means the representation or reproduction of words, symbols or other information in a visible form by any method or combination of methods whether sent or supplied electronically."

#### **Motion B**

It was **resolved** by the requisite majority, 45 for, none against and 6 abstentions, to add the Honorary Librarian and Heritage Trustee as a member of Council by making the following amendment:-

In Law 1.1 of Chapter X add, "j the Honorary Librarian and Heritage Trustee" and re-letter accordingly.

## **Motion C**

It was **resolved** by the requisite majority, 40 for, 7 against and 5 abstentions, to remove the statement that the "Fellowship with Distinction" would not normally be awarded to those elected as President or Vice President by making the following amendment:-

In Law 1 of Chapter XX, delete the sentence, 'This honour would not normally be awarded to those elected as President or Vice President, as they are honoured by College in other ways'.
